Case Study: Dr. Robert Rohm, Sharon Baptist Church

The Problem...

The traditional format for the Sharon Baptist Church Annual Marriage Retreat consists of 3 days retreat off site, with multiple training/learning sessions. Prior to each sessions there would be a musician playing different styles of relaxing music. By the time the trainer would start the next session the audience would often be too relaxed and even asleep. This made it hard for the speakers who first had to re-energize and wake-up the audience before starting their sessions. The pre-session entertainment was not working and needed to change.

The Solution...

The Sharon Baptist Church annual marriage retreat organizing committee decided to hire a comedian to re-energize the room with 10-15 minute sets prior to each training/learning session.
